ETHICS COMMISSION EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR ELECTED PRESIDENT OF PROFESSIONAL ETHICS ORGANIZATION

At its annual conference last week, Ohio Ethics Commission Executive Director Paul M. Nick was elected as the 2017 president for the Council on Governmental Ethics Laws (COGEL). This election recognizes Director Nick's ongoing commitment to promote ethics in government with colleagues and the public.
