



OHIO ETHICS COMMISSION

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Public Officials or Employees Required to File Financial Disclosure Statements by Commission Decision (under R.C. 102.02(B))

Effective: 12/3/2025

The Ohio Ethics Law requires some public officials and employees to file annual financial disclosure statements. R.C. 102.02(A). In addition, the Ohio Ethics Commission may require additional classes of public officials or employees whose positions involve a substantial and material exercise of administrative discretion in the formulation of public policy, expenditure of public funds, enforcement of laws and rules of the state or a county or city, or the execution of other public trusts, to file annual financial disclosure statements. R.C. 102.02(B) and Administrative Rules No. 102-5-04 and 102-5-05. This document lists the public entities whose officials or employees are required to file by Commission decision. The Commission will update this document and add additional classes of public officials or employees and/or the entities they serve as necessary.

1. State Boards and Commissions

Under its authority granted in R.C. 102.02(B), the Commission has required the chief executive officers and board members of a number of state boards and commissions and other entities who exercise the power of the state to file financial disclosure statements.

Statements filed by the chief executive officers are subject to public inspection. Statements filed by board members of these entities are subject to public inspection if the board members are compensated for their public service (listed in the left column). If the members of the board are not compensated for their service, the law requires that their statements are kept confidential and are not subject to public inspection (listed in the right column). However, if any portion of a confidential statement discloses the potential for a conflict of interest, that portion of the statement will be made public.

Listed below, in **alphabetical order**, are the state boards and commissions whose chief executive officers and board members (unless noted otherwise) or designees are required to file financial disclosure statements with the Commission. The boards and commissions listed in the left column are those whose members file public statements; the boards and commissions in the right column are those whose members file confidential statements.

2. State Universities and Colleges

Under its authority granted in R.C. 102.02(B), the Commission has also required the following state university or college officials and employees to file disclosure statements with the Commission:

- Members of a state university or college board of trustees;
- Members of a technical college trustee selection committee; and
- For any state university or college under a fiscal watch (as certified by the Chancellor of Higher Education):
 - Conservator [Appointed by the Governor (R.C. 3345.74)];
 - Governance Authority Member (R.C. 3345.75);
 - Executive Director [Appointed by a Governance Authority (R.C. 3345.75)]

Statements filed by a Conservator or Executive Director of a state university or college that is under a fiscal watch are subject to public inspection. However, because they are not compensated for their public service, the law requires that statements filed by university or college trustees, technical college trustee

selection committee members, and university or college governance authority members are kept confidential and are not subject to public inspection. However, if any portion of a confidential statement discloses the potential for a conflict of interest, that portion of the statement will be made public.

3. Community Based Correctional Facilities (CBCF)

Under its authority granted in R.C. 102.02(B), the Commission has also required the director of any Community Based Correctional Facility (CBCF) operating in the state to file a financial disclosure statement with the Commission. Because they are compensated for their public service, statements filed by the director of a CBCF are subject to public inspection.

PLEASE NOTE: This document does **NOT** list every class of public official or employee required to file a financial disclosure statement with the Commission. This document only lists the additional classes of public officials or employees required to file as a result of Commission decision under R.C. 102.02(B). R.C. 102.02(A) and other statutes require many more classes of public officials or employees to file financial disclosure statements.
