

FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE NOTIFICATION APPOINTEES TO UNEXPIRED TERM IN ELECTIVE OFFICE

Because you have been appointed to an unexpired term in one of the following elective offices in 2022, you are required to file a financial disclosure statement for calendar year 2021 with the Ohio Ethics Commission*:

- State elected office
- County elected office
- City elected office
- School district board of education
(district with more than 12,000 students)
- ESC governing board member
(ESC with more than 12,000 students)

***PLEASE NOTE:** All appointees to the Ohio General Assembly file with the Joint Legislative Ethics Committee and all judicial appointees file with the Ohio Board of Professional Conduct.

The financial disclosure statement is available on the Ohio Ethics Commission’s Web site at <https://ethics.ohio.gov/forms/> or you can file electronically at <https://disclosure.ethics.ohio.gov>. It is **your** responsibility to access, complete, and file the statement by the deadline that applies to you.

Please note that you will file a statement with our office every year you hold the position and the year after you leave.

DEADLINE INFORMATION FOR APPOINTEES TO ELECTIVE OFFICES:

The statement is due **15 days after** you qualify for the office to which you have been appointed. You qualify for the office after you have been sworn in to the office. If the fifteenth day falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or state holiday, the statement is due on the following business day.

For example:

SWORN-IN DATE	FIFTEEN DAYS	FILING DEADLINE
Wednesday, June 1, 2022	Wednesday, June 16, 2022	Thursday, June 16, 2022
Friday, August 5, 2022	Saturday, August 20, 2022	Monday, August 22, 2022
Sunday, August 21, 2022	Monday, September 5, 2022	Tuesday, September 6, 2022 (Monday September 5 is Labor Day, a state holiday)
